CONDITIONS OF COMMUNITY SUPERVISION

In accordance with the authority conferred by the Community Supervision Law of the State of Texas, you have been placed on COMMUNITY SUPERVISION for a period of 10 years by the Judge of the 443RD Judicial District Court, ELLIS County, Texas.

It is the order of this Court that you shall comply with the following Conditions of Community Supervision:

- (1) Commit no offense against the laws of this or any other State or of the United States; further, report to your community supervision officer within 48 hours if arrested or questioned by any law enforcement officer;
- (2) Avoid injurious or vicious habits; abstain from the use of alcoholic beverages and any product containing alcohol and do not use any illegal drug or controlled substance unless prescribed by a licensed physician for legitimate purposes. Provide proof of all current prescription medications to your supervision officer;
- (3) Avoid persons or places of disreputable or harmful character, including but not limited to voluntarily associating with persons previously convicted of a crime, being present where a criminal act is being committed, and do not frequent or patronize any establishment where the primary source of income is through the sale of alcoholic beverages, including but not limited to bars, strip clubs, and liquor/package stores;
- (4) Within 48 hours, report to the Ellis County CSCD located at 202 Clift Street, Waxahachie, Texas 75165, Phone Number 972-825-5130, as directed by the court and/or the community supervision officer. Obey all the rules and regulations of said department;
- (5) Permit the supervision officer or any peace officer to inspect and search your home, personal property, or place of business for any prohibited items or contraband in your home, property, vehicle or place of business at any time;
- (6) Work faithfully at suitable employment as far as possible and submit verification of said employment as directed. If instructed by your community supervision officer, participate in the job/career placement program. Report any changes in employment within 48 hours;
- (7) Remain in Ellis County, Texas unless authorized to leave. Any travel over 100 miles out of said county will require written authorization.
All overnight stays outside Ellis County must be pre-approved.
- (8) Support the dependents that you have now or that you acquire during the period of supervision. Comply with all court-ordered financial obligations not limited to court-ordered child support, medical expenses, counseling expense payments, and insurance requirements;
- (9) Pay a reimbursement fee of \$60.00/ \$ _____ per month to the community supervision department on or before the 15th day of each month hereafter during the supervision in the month next following entry of this order;
- (10) Make payments to the Ellis County Community Supervision and Corrections Department as follows:

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- (1) Commit no offense against the laws of this or any other State or of the United States; further, report to your community supervision officer within 48 hours if arrested or questioned by any law enforcement officer;
- (2) Avoid injurious or vicious habits; abstain from the use of alcoholic beverages and any product containing alcohol and do not use any illegal drug or controlled substance unless prescribed by a licensed physician for legitimate purposes. Provide proof of all current prescription medications to your supervision officer;
- (3) Avoid persons or places of disreputable or harmful character, including but not limited to voluntarily associating with persons previously convicted of a crime, being present where a criminal act is being committed, and do not frequent or patronize any establishment where the primary source of income is through the sale of alcoholic beverages, including but not limited to bars, strip clubs, and liquor/package stores;
- (4) Within 48 hours, report to the Ellis County CSCD located at 202 Clift Street, Waxahachie, Texas 75165, Phone Number 972-825-5130, as directed by the court and/or the community supervision officer. Obey all the rules and regulations of said department;
- (5) Permit the supervision officer or any peace officer to inspect and search your home, personal property, or place of business for any prohibited items or contraband in your home, property, vehicle or place of business at any time;
- (6) Work faithfully at suitable employment as far as possible and submit verification of said employment as directed. If instructed by your community supervision officer, participate in the job/career placement program. Report any changes in employment within 48 hours;
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All overnight stays outside Ellis County must be pre-approved.
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- (9) Pay a reimbursement fee of \$60.00/ \$_____ per month to the community supervision department on or before the 15th day of each month hereafter during the supervision in the month next following entry of this order;
- (10) Make payments to the Ellis County Community Supervision and Corrections Department as follows:

- (11) Defendant shall provide a copy of his filed federal income tax return each year to his or her assigned supervision officer. The defendant will be required to pay at least fifty percent (50%) of his or her federal income tax refund to the Ellis County Community Supervision and Corrections Department toward any delinquencies owed to the Community Supervision Department;
 - (12) Submit to testing for alcohol or controlled substances, including the taking of one or more specimens of your breath or blood for the purpose of analysis to determine the alcohol concentration or presence of a controlled substance or drug if requested to do so by a peace officer investigating any intoxication offense;
 - (13) Submit to testing for drugs or alcohol as directed. Submit to any type of test requested by the community supervision department supervising your case not limited to urine, hair, buccal swab, sweat, and/or breath at your own expense;
 - (14) Perform community service work as designated by the Community Supervision Department and approved by the Court in the amount of _____ **hours**. The Court determines that the performance of such service will work a hardship on the defendant or the defendant's dependents in the event defendant maintains full time employment. Defendant is excused from such service during those periods of full-time employment as verified by the Community Service Department. In the event of unemployment or inability to verify employment, defendant must perform community service at a rate of 24 hours per week;
 - (15) Submit to a substance abuse evaluation within 60 days and comply with any recommendations made by said evaluation;
 - (16) Submit to a psychological/psychiatric evaluation and follow any recommendation made by said evaluation if directed to by the supervision officer;
 - (17) Avoid contact or communication with _____, the victim(s) of this offense, and do not go near any residence, business, school, or other location where the victim(s) is known to frequent;
 - (18) Remain under custodial supervision and serve _____ in the Ellis County Wayne McCollum Detention Center, beginning ____ **INSTANTER** or on _____. You shall be credited with **0 DAYS**;
 - (19) Observe a curfew, be home, and remain home each night from 11pm-5am, or within 30 minutes of night time employment, whichever is later;
 - (20) Within 60 days, submit proof of High School education or GED certificate or enroll in an Adult Basic Education program as directed by your supervision officer and obtain a High School Diploma or GED certificate within one (1) year of the entry of this order;
 - (21) Submit your DNA sample to the Department of Public Safety under Government Code, Chapter 411, Subchapter G, for the purpose of establishing a DNA record, under the direction of the Community Supervision Department and at your own expense;
 - (22) You shall not possess any firearm, explosive devices, or muzzle loader in your home, vehicle, or place of business, unless you obtain written permission from the Court or your supervision officer;
 - (23) Comply with any other condition that your community supervision officer deems reasonably necessary for your rehabilitation, or the protection of the victim or the community;
- In addition, you shall comply with and faithfully obey, during the entire supervisory period, the following special conditions of supervision as set forth in Module(s): _____. and the following special conditions: Drivers Safety Course

You are hereby admonished that under the laws of this State, the Court shall determine the terms and conditions of your community supervision and may, upon a finding that you have violated any of the terms and conditions stated above, revoke, modify or amend the conditions of your community supervision.
